

Privacy Policy

The General Data Protection Regulations came into force on the 25th May 2018. It is an EU legislation protecting personal data and providing electronic privacy that the UK has maintained since leaving the EU. This law is built around the principles of transparency and control.

We are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This policy explains when and why we collect personal information, how we process it and how we use it.

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer to collect standard internet log information and visitor behaviour information in anonymous for such as repeat visits, time spent on pages and pages of interest.

How we will use your information
